



## **SUGGESTED VERSES FOR MEMORIZATION & MEDITATION**

- I know where you dwell, where Satan's throne is. Yet you hold fast my name, and you did not deny my faith even in the days of Antipas my faithful witness, who was killed among you, where Satan dwells. (Revelation 2:13)
- Therefore repent. If not, I will come to you soon and war against them with the sword of my mouth. (Revelation 2:16)
- Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for he who promising is faithful. (Hebrews 10:23)

### **READ VERSES 12-13 AND DISCUSS THE FOLLOWING**

1. Though the Christians in Pergamum dwelled where Satan's throne is, Jesus commends that they have held fast to Him and did not deny the faith. How does the Bible instruct us to hold fast to Christ?

### **READ VERSES 14-15 AND DISCUSS THE FOLLOWING**

2. In His rebuke against the church of Pergamum, Christ states that some of them were deviating into false teachings and sinful behavior of the culture around them. What are some false teachings and sinful behaviors of today's culture?

### **READ VERSES 16-17 AND DISCUSS THE FOLLOWING**

3. Christ claims that unless the church at Pergamum repents it will find itself at war against Jesus Himself. Why is repentance so significant in the life of a follower of Christ and to the church community?

## **ACTIONS TO CONSIDER**

- Just as some in Pergamum were being swept away by the sins and false teachings of the society among them, consider areas of your life in which you may be doing the same thing, and repent of them.
